

Kellogg Inclusion Study Grant

Southwest ISD is in a multi-year partnership with Texas A&M, College Station, for the Kellogg Inclusion Research Project, which funds an inclusion study at Southwest ISD. With these funds, eight campuses receive funds to complete specific approved activities based research based techniques to improve on Parental Engagement, use of Data Analysis, Career & College Readiness, and Literacy. The university collaborates with the district on best practices across the nation and provides technical assistance, monthly trainings, onboarding summer training, and guidance on program evaluations. In addition, Texas A&M completes quantitative and qualitative studies on focus groups, data analysis, empathy mapping, student voice sessions, trainings, and survey development. This program is monitored through the Department of External Programs.

Schools participating are: Southwest Legacy High School, Resnik Middle School, McAuliffe Middle School, Bob Hope Elementary, Spicewood Park Elementary, Indian Creek Elementary, Hidden Cove Elementary, and Sky Harbour Elementary.
